Town Board Meeting – Town of Hammel – September 12, 2023

Chairman Livingston called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. All board members were present with the exception of Supervisor Zenner. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Steve updated on the broadband topic. Stated that they are working on a couple of towers east of town. Steve reported that the estimated cost of the Clear Lake culvert replacement will be around \$93,897 with the town's share running approximately \$46,985. It will go to the County board with a request for bridge aid to help the cost.

Brad reported that the roads have received some moisture so he is able to grade them. He is working on the ditching on Gasek and has completed the second round of mowing. Sawyer Avenue had the chip seal applied and it looks nice.

LRIP: Chairman Livingston reported that no determinations have been made at this time for the allocation of funds. Steve added that the Road Improvement Plan has Clear Lake Road for improvement in 2025. Budget meeting will be held 10/24/23 at 6 p.m.
