

Town board meeting- Town of Hammel- October 14, 2025

The town board meeting was called to order by Chairman Joe Zenner at 6:00 p.m on Tuesday, October 14, 2025, at the Hammel town hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. All board members were present.

Meeting minutes from September 12, 2025, were reviewed. Motion to approve the minutes made by Supervisor Emmerich. Seconded by Chairman Joe Zenner.

Treasurer Rhonda Seidl gave the treasurer's report. Supervisor Zenner made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. Supervisor Emmerich seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Open discussion- Jim Livingston thanked the town for using the town hall for the veteran hunt. It was a successful hunt and the town hall worked well for the veterans. Discussion was had on the website being updated with the meeting minutes. Board members also need to be updated on the website. Discussion was had on the travel fund- \$14,000 was going to be used for the clear lake project and partial of the money was given back to the county to be divided. Part of money was used, and a sum of money was forfeited to the county. Question was asked on the Center Avenue decision for asphalt or crack sealing. The plan so far is to go two 1 ½ in layers on the road. Laura Lundy came to speak as the superintendent of the school district about the groundbreaking of the new addition to the school. Construction has been delayed for a month, and plan is for the new addition to be added onto the south wall. Hope is for the rooms to be used for classes by next school year. Tech Ed building is going to also have upgrades and an expansion. Bathroom updates are also being done to all schools.

Road update left by Brad Clarkson. Chip sealing updates. Crack fill and chip sealing in the next 3-5 years quotes from the county.

Engineering on Center avenue on the 50/50 and 30/10. Discussion was had on the project details and grants. Road documentation for grants was discussed. Crack sealing update as it is currently completed.

Recycle Update: Meeting coming up.

Bills were examined. Supervisor Emmerich made a motion to pay the bills. Supervisor Mike Eckland seconded the motion. Motion carried.
