

Town Board Meeting – Town of Hammel – December 9, 2025

The town board meeting was called to order by Chairman Joe Zenner at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 9, 2025 at the Hammel town hall. All board members were present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the November 17, 2025 public hearing on the proposed 2026 budget of the Town of Hammel were read. The minutes of the November 17, 2025 special meeting of the electors were read. The minutes of the November 17, 2024 board meeting were read. Chairman Zenner made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Supervisor Emmerich seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Treasurer's report was read. Supervisor Ecklund made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Supervisor Emmerich seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Brad reported that the roads are currently snowy. The ditching across from Jack Johnson's has stopped due to the weather. Supervisor Ecklund made a motion to donate the used culverts from the project to George Kalmon in exchange for overburden purchased. Chairman Zenner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Garbage bags for the town were discussed for the garbage collection as the supply is running low. It was decided to remove the old telephone number that is not in use from the bags. Supervisor Ecklund made a motion to purchase new bags at 50 boxes at a cost of \$3325.00. Supervisor Emmerich seconded the motion for purchase.
